**Massabielle / SOLL Pilgrimage to Lourdes 24<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> May 2024:** Birmingham to Tarbes. The cost this year will be an incredibly competitive subsidised price of £690.00 Inc Lourdes levy and coach travel from Keighley, based on 2 sharing. This price excludes travel Insurance of £49 up to 79 and £98 for 80 plus, you can use your own insurance instead if you wish. Single room occupancy is an additional £273. Helper pilgrims can apply for a further subsidy grant if the above price is financially difficult, via SOLL grant committee. Supported pilgrims booking in the Accueil (Care/Nursing home facility), which gives full medical and physical support the cost is £500 all inclusive. Any booking will require SOLL medical approval before acceptance. A subsidy grant if the above price is financially difficult, via SOLL grant committee is also available.
